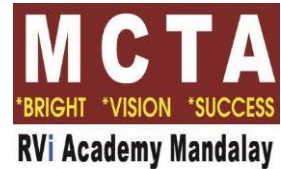

Needs Assessment:

- More than 200 orphans at the Kyause Temple in Mandalay are without any means of health care.
- ODFL does not normally fund project set in a religious-context but this is the only recourse for these children.



Myanmar is one of the poorest countries in the world. Outside of Mandalay, a southern city, a Buddhist temple has taken in more than 230 orphans who had been abandoned and left on the streets of the city. They were without food, shelter, education, medical care, or vocation.

The temple provides most of these necessities to the orphans. But it is not equipped to deal with the health care needs of so many children. Those range from malnutrition to vaccinations, common infections, chronic diseases, injuries, and more. Some conditions are life-threatening.

This project will build a simple medical clinic on the temple grounds to serve the health care needs of these orphans. It will be simple but functional, including an admitting room, a procedure room, a recovery room, and a small office.

The clinic will be constructed by temple monks with ODFL and MCTA providing locally-sourced materials. It will be provisioned by contributions from the local community, including staffing, equipment, and medications.
