Dear Fellow Altruist/Activist,

Thank you for considering being an ODFL Philanthropreneur. If just a few of us will take the lead in recruiting others we will do amazing things. Our experience with teenagers is the proof: in 9 years, we've built 79 projects in the developing world.

This program for *adult* altruists is still being set up. On the web page, above, are a Brochure and a Letter to possible investors. You can also see information about each of the Projects we have available. For most of them there's a video as well.

We are building more such tools but rather than building them for building's sake, we would like to know from you what you need to help carry the message to friends and colleagues. Please call or email me with any requests or ideas.

To get started, let me know your name and the names of any team members working to fund your project. We will acknowledge everyone who helps unless they request otherwise. But we don't divulge specific contributions at the personal level.

We will keep you updated with regular information on funding and project status. Typically, when we have 60% of the funds in hand we begin construction. Time for Project completion varies, taking from a few weeks to three months.

If you would like me to speak to a group of your friends or colleagues, let me know. I have a lot of freedom to do this in the Bay Area. It's a pretty inspiring presentation. If you need ODFL literature, let me know. If you need ANYthing ODFL, let me know.

Again, this is new so we appreciate your patience as we mature it. But the ethos behind it is good: that if we will all do a small bit, the effect is enormous. WE will become the creators of the world we want to believe is possible.
